THE POSITION

This is the first professional placement of the Media RING Fellowship. This position provides an early career Queensland Indigenous screen industry professional with an opportunity to support Screen Queensland's (SQ) Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Program and its work within the broader Queensland screen industry for a period of six months, followed by a further six-month placement with Australia's home of Indigenous storytelling, NITV in Sydney.

This is an identified position. It is a genuine occupational requirement that this position is filled by an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander. Evidence of cultural background may be required for appointment to this position.

ABOUT the Media RING Fellowship

The Media RING Fellowship is a program which has been designed to provide career opportunities for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Australians in the Australian screen industry. It has been developed to be delivered on a case by case basis when Media RING Members can provide placement and attachment opportunities when they become available.

- 1. Knowledge and understanding of the richness and vibrancy of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander peoples, culture and communities across Queensland and Australia
- 2. Demonstrated commitment to the screen industry and passion for the production of screen stories as a long-term career objective
- 3. Demonstrated engaging and open written and personal communication skills
- 4. Demonstrated organizational skills, with great attention to detail and time management skills
- 5. Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite
- 6. Residency in Queensland for at least six months prior to application
- 7. Preparedness to relocate to Sydney for six months.

This position is not suitable for students.
