

1. Screen Queensland Credit

- 1.1 The Production Company shall ensure that the following locked Screen Queensland logo and Queensland Government logo (colour to be black and white) (the "**Credit**") is included as a static logo credit or rolling logo credit (but only if all other end credits are rolling) in the end titles of the Project as follows, on a single card:

FILMED IN QUEENSLAND, AUSTRALIA WITH FUNDING FROM SCREEN QUEENSLAND

(Horizontal:)



Or

(Stacked:)



- 1.2 The Credit must:
- (a) conform with Screen Queensland's standard artwork provided by Screen Queensland to the Production Company on or prior to the date of this Agreement (which is reproduced above); and
 - (b) be no smaller or less prominent than the credit and logo of any investor/financier in the Project also receiving credit in the end credits or any other Australian state government providing a production incentive or financing of the same or lesser value to the Project.
- 1.3 Screen Queensland grants the Production Company a limited, non-exclusive, revocable licence to use the locked logo in accordance with this clause 6. For clarity, Screen Queensland may, at any time upon notice in writing to the Production Company, decline to require or permit its credit to be used in the Project or any advertising, promotional or publicity material for the Project. Once the credits (including Screen Queensland's review and approval of its Credit) are locked, the license is irrevocable

Acknowledgement of Country Credit

- 1.4 Unless there is already a general acknowledgement of country included in the Project, the Production Company shall ensure an end credit is included in the Project that acknowledges the traditional indigenous country names of the locations on which the Project is filmed and produced, substantively in the form of the following:

AS THE TRADITIONAL CUSTODIANS OF THE LANDS ON WHICH FILMING WAS
UNDERTAKEN**
